

As Kitty's Kap

Size 8 circular needles (or 7)

Size 8 double-point needles

Cast on 88 stitches.

Place marker and join being careful not to twist.

Knit all rounds for about 1 inch. (about 10-12 rows) You can also k2p2 for 10-12 rows if you don't want a rolled edge. Brim Shown: Row 1: Knit, Row 2: Purl, Row 3: Knit



Pattern:

Row 1: Knit 3, slip one stitch *as if to purl*, repeat to end of row

Row 2: Knit 3, slip one stitch *as if to purl*, repeat to end of row

Row 3: Knit 3, slip one stitch *as if to purl*, repeat to end of row

Row 4: Knit all around to end of row

Repeat pattern to desired length – I go until hat measures from the end to about 6-7”

Decrease:

Row 1: Knit 9, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 2: Knit all around

Row 3: Knit 8, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 4: Knit all around

Row 5: Knit 7, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 6: Knit all around

Row 7: Knit 6, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 8: Knit all around

Row 9: Knit 5, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 10: Knit all around

Change to double-points

Row 11: Knit 4, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 12: Knit 3, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 13: Knit 2, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 14: Knit 1, k2 together, repeat to end of row

Row 15: k2 together all around

Cut yarn leaving a 10” tail, thread it through the remaining stitches, draw up tightly, and weave in the ends.
