

JOLINE'S KNIT CAP



Materials:

Size 8 circular needles

Size 8 double-pointed needles

Caron Simply Soft yarn or any approved yarn of same weight/ply

Marker

Darning needle

Cast on 80 stitches

Work K2, P2 or K1, P1 ribbing for 6 to 8 rows

Pattern:

(Pattern is 5 rows deep, four sts wide and there are 20 patterns in a row.)

Row 1, 2, 3 & 4: *K3, P1* repeat from ** to end of rnd

Row 5: *P3, K1* repeat from ** to end of rnd

Place marker over top of yarn between last and next stitch at end of row

Repeat pattern 5 or 6 times until cap measures 6 inches.

Decrease:

Change to double-pointed needles when desired.

From now on, all stitches will be knitted.

Decrease rows equal 2 inches.

Note: Knit even rows (no decreasing.)

Row 1: *K8, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (70)

Row 2 and all alternate (even) rows knit entire row

Row 3: *K7, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (60)

Row 5: *K6, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (50)

Row 7: *K5, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (40)

Row 9: *K4, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (30)

Row 11: *K3, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (20)

Row 13: *K2, K2 tog* repeat from ** to end of rnd (10)

Cut yarn, leaving a 7-inch tail and thread onto darning needle. Run yarn through remaining sts. twice. Fasten off, securing from inside of cap. Cut remaining tail.
