

Loom Knitting Instructions for Chemo Cap

Materials Needed:

Knifty Knitter Loom – green (with 36 pegs)
(This cap will fit adult women and most men.)
Crochet hook – size J
Hook tool
Yarn recommended – Caron Simply Soft

Instructions for a cap with a rolled brim:

Use two strands of yarn.
Two cast on methods can be used: either the chain cast on method or e-wrap. The cast on method gives a neat, flexible, non-loopy, crochet-like edge, but the e-wrap works well, too. The e-wrap is a bit more loopy though.
After the cast on row use a single stitch e-wrap for approximately 27 rows or 7", whichever occurs first for a woman's cap.
For a man's cap add several more rows until it measures between 7 ½ - 8".
Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail.
Bind off using the cinched or gathered method.
Weave in all yarn tail ends and cut off any excess.

Instructions for a cap with a straight bottom:

Use two strands of yarn.
Use either the chain cast on method or the e-wrap.
To create a single layer brim: For rows 1, 3, and 5 use a single stitch e-wrap.
For rows 2, 4, and 6 use a purl stitch. By doing this the bottom will lay straight and will not roll.
For rows 7 – 28 (approximately) use the single stitch e-wrap until you reach 7" for a woman's cap or row 31 (approximately) or until you reach 7 ½" – 8" for a man's cap.

Instructions for a cap with a Fun Fur brim:

This cap is made the same way as the one above except for using Fun Fur for the first 6 rows.
